The state of emergency has been declared for Bavaria up until 18th April 2021 due to the Coronavirus pandemic.

On Sunday, 4th April 2021, the Robert-Koch-Institut published an incidence rate of 94 for Erlangen-Höchstadt. Due to the regulations of the 12th Bavarian Infection Protection Measures Ordinance, the measures and regulations for an incidence rate under 100 will come into effect, starting on Tuesday, 6th April 2021.
