Under the structure plan of the Association of German Music Schools (VdM) the children begin their music instruction at the elementary level in the courses MFE (Early Musical Education). Our qualified teaching staff teaches the listed instrumental and vocal subjects according to the guidelines of the VdM.

Basic Classes for children

Early Musical Education (MFE I)

In this course children are taught music in a playful way – through singing, speaking and listening, movement, dancing and instruments.

For children at the age of 4; duration of course: 1 year continuation possible.

Early Musical Education (MFE II)

Rhythmic training, singing, playing with Orff-instruments and a little insight of the different types of instruments.

For children at the age of 5; duration of course: 1 year

Drum group

Takes place after MFE courses as a continuation. For children at the age of 6; duration of course: 1 year, group 4 children No trial period.

Instrument carousel

Children get to know successively piano, recorder and ukulele. For children at the age of 6; duration of course: 1 year, group 4 children. No trial period.

Piano plays

Playing possibilities of the piano are discovered with the methods of the Early Musical Education and are tested.

For children at the age of 6; duration of course: 1 year, group 4 children.

No trial period.

Main Classes

Instrumental instruction of pupils in the lower levels takes place primarily with partners or in small groups (3 children). Individual instruction is usually given after some years of learning.
